Deadlines and \$ Details

Annual Grant Deadlines

Ap 1 & Oct 1 at 4:00 p.m.

Annual grants support programs that are no more than 12 months in length and are not summer programs. Programs may be offered continuously throughout the year, may be for a defined time period (e.g., an 8 week program), or may be shortterm projects such as a one-day training session.

Annual Grant Amounts

Maximum of \$25,000 / local project Maximum of \$50,000 / provincial project **Summer Grant Deadline** February 1 at 4:00 p.m.

Summer grants support programs held between May 1 & August 31. Summer grants support only programs, or the portion of programs, that benefit children & youth – grants are not intended to support adult programs that occur during the summer, events, or the summer portion of annual programs.

Summer Grant Amount Maximum of \$5,000

Local projects benefit residents of one community or region. **Provincial projects** are a) delivered in two or more regions; or b) involve participation from across Saskatchewan. Find your <u>CIF Region</u> by community or view the <u>Regional Map</u>.

Before completing your grant application, you are strongly encouraged to read through the **<u>guidelines</u>** to ensure your project and expenses are eligible.
