

## Temporary Subsidy for Employee Training Costs

- » The Re-Open Saskatchewan Training Subsidy provides a 100% reimbursement of up to \$10,000 for businesses to train employees, and support the safe re-opening of businesses in accordance with the Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan.
- » This subsidy is available to private and not-for-profit employers currently listed as *critical public services and allowable businesses* in the Re-Open Saskatchewan plan.

**The Re-Open Saskatchewan Training Subsidy (RSTS) application deadline has been extended to December 31, 2020.** Private employers can access up to \$10,000 for training that supports adjustment to the impacts of the pandemic and safely aligns business activities with the re-opening phases of Saskatchewan's economy.

The program is an employer-driven, short term training program that provides eligible employers with financial support to train existing employees.

Applicants must demonstrate that the requested training supports the safe re-opening of the service or business, increased health and safety requirements, or adoption of innovative practices that align with social distancing protocols.
