REACT Curbside Pickup – Continued consideration.

REACT fees for garbage tags are \$4.50 per bag. Tags can be purchased at the village office.

Deliberations are still under way in determining whether it is in residents' best interest to switch to curbside pickup. Curbside pickup price has been quoted at ~\$14 per month based on 200 homes. Data has been compiled in May and June. We are finding that typically only ~80 homes or less are setting out trash on a weekly basis. The curbside quote is based on 200 homes. If the number of pickups

decrease to only 80 homes the cost of the pickup could increase to ~\$24.00+ per month. The curbside pickup would occur once every two weeks and pickup garbage only – no recycling at this time.

Public Works - Roads

Road crowning, edging, culvert improvements and surface water drainage have been our focus over the past month. We would like to thank residents for their patience as poor weather has altered our timeline and often caused impromptu work where/when it was not planned. We appreciate all efforts by residents to not be parked on the streets as roadwork progresses. See attached work schedule.
