A Message from our Outgoing Administrative Assistant

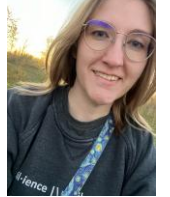


Dear Residents,

REACT Curbside Pickup Curbside Garbage Bins

Important Dates:
1. Tues, April 2, 2025 Curbside Garbage Bins arrive.
2. Thurs April 10, 2025 First scheduled garbage pickup.

*Garbage Fee \$13.47 + fuel surcharge will show on April 1st utility bills and each monthly utility bill going forward.

*Each bin delivered has a serial number for tracking purposes that will link it to the individual property it is assigned to.

*There will be a brochure attached to the bin on how to adapt to the new bin usage.

*Bin Pick-up will be mandatory for all Muenster households, and optional for businesses.

2025 Property Assessments

Notice is hereby given that the assessment roll for the Village of Muenster for the year of 2025 has been prepared and is open to inspection by calling 306-682-2794, or visiting the office of the assessor from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on the following days: Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays

The roll will remain open until April 15, 2025.

Any person who wishes to appeal his or her assessment is required to file his or her notice of appeal, accompanied by a **\$250.00 appeal fee by April 15, 2025 at 3:30 pm.**

2025 Tax Payments

The 2025 tax levy is scheduled to go out June 1, with taxes due by December 31, 2025.

Anyone wishing to make installments may now start for 2025. We are happy to accept post-dated cheques for the year if that is your preference.



Pet Licenses

Annual Pet Licenses were due January 31, 2025. License fees are \$10 per dog and

\$10 per cat. **If you haven’t already, please stop by the village office for your 2025 tag(s).**

Paperless Billing

Get your monthly utility notices and receipts via Email. Contact the Village Office...we'd be happy to "hook you up." Just fill out a consent form and give us your Email address...let's save the Village substantial costs of printing, invoice forms, envelopes, and postage.

5000 Kg Weight Limit in Town

We would like to remind residents, farmers and corporations of the weight restrictions of 5000 kg in the Village. – especially on our newly reno'd Rangeline and on Railway Street. Failure to abide can result in significant fines.

Fire Response Coverage

Does your Home Insurance cover costs incurred if the Fire Department has to respond to an incident or fire at your property?

You may want to consider whether you wish to take out insurance to cover the costs of Fire Departments responding to calls.

Residents are charged for Fire Departments' response time (even if there is not a fire). Fire Departments can be required to assist when an ambulance is called to a scene.

The provincial dispatch service determines if the call out of Fire and/or RCMP is required to certain situations.

*Not all Insurance companies cover costs for Fire/Responders' labor on such call outs. Check your policy!

Spring Melt

Large quantities of snow remaining in yards in the spring can take time to melt. Continue to watch your basements to avoid water issues.

- Automated Fund Transfer for Utility payments – contact the Village office to sign up for automatic withdrawal from your account on the last day of each month
- Internet Banking through any Credit Union or CIBC *
- Cash or Cheque by mail, in person, or by the drop-off chute available 24/7 (we encourage residents to use this to avoid late payments).
